Scaramouche is pleased to present *Sharing the Flame*, a group exhibition uniting artists of diverse generations and geographic origins in an expansive visual and cultural dialogue, **on view February 4 through May 9, 2026.**

The show celebrates values of affinity and esteem through an exhibition itinerary in which language, sensibility and varied cultures engage and coexist. The works on view are a testimony to the capacity of art to go beyond geographic and cultural confines, affirming its place as a common ground for exchange and reciprocal appreciation.

Sharing the Flame invites the public to discover a plurality of views that upon meeting, generates a new form of unity: a shared flame that spreads through diverse signs, materials, visions and poetics, symbolically evoking the ideals of continuity, transition and community that animate the Winter Olympic Games of Milano-Cortina.

The exhibition features prominent artists of international renown including **Yayoi Kusama, Roy Lichtenstein, Anselm Kiefer, Alighiero Boetti**, and **Louise Nevelson**, together with other pivotal figures of the Post-War and Contemporary originating from Europe, United States, Asia, Middle East and Latin America.

Artists including **Lucio Fontana, Cy Twombly, Andy Warhol, Keith Haring, Jannis Kounellis, Mario Ceroli, Francesco Clemente, Luigi Ontani, Giò Pomodoro, Ed Ruscha, Damien Hirst, Julio Le Parc, Sebastian Matta**, and **Aref El Rayess** coalesce with many others in an itinerary that includes painting and sculpture.

With *Sharing the Flame*, Scaramouche reflects on art as a space for rapport and commonality, capable of generating authentic connections in an evermore fragmented world.
